As part of our commitment to responsible sourcing, our policy is to prioritise purchase of raw material from suppliers that hold a recognizable responsible sourcing accreditation such as BES6001, we are also able to trace 100% of this material back to the manufacturer and past. This traceability is maintained throughout the production process and final delivery to the customer.
